Classic 1957 Chevrolet Bel Air 4-door sedan project car in original two-tone copper and cream color scheme. This iconic American automobile exemplifies the distinctive styling of Chevrolet's Tri-Five era (1955-1957) with its signature tailfins, chrome trim, and panoramic windshield. The vehicle retains its original body shell with the characteristic side sweep spear trim and four-door configuration.

This project car presents with complete door panels, windshield framework, and recognizable dashboard structure. The interior features remnants of the original bench seating with ribbed upholstery pattern. Body panels show the factory two-tone paint combination that made these vehicles instantly recognizable. The chassis appears largely intact, maintaining the original wheel placement and structural components.

Condition Notes: Engine, transmission, front end components, and drivetrain are missing. Significant rust present throughout the body panels, particularly in the lower sections and floor pans. Extensive body damage to the front end with missing grille, bumper, and headlight assemblies. Rear driver's side fender has been cut out. Interior is heavily deteriorated with damaged upholstery, missing components, and weathered surfaces. Shattered windshield. Dashboard instruments and controls missing. Body shows extensive surface rust and patina. Four tires present but in poor condition. Refer to the pictures and in-person inspection for condition.
