This collectible silver dollar was minted during a significant period in Western U.S. history when Nevada's Carson City Mint was producing coins from locally-mined Comstock Lode silver. Carson City mint marks are particularly sought after by collectors due to their limited mintage numbers compared to other U.S. mints, with the facility only producing coins from 1870 to 1893.

Condition Notes: Coin displays natural toning and moderate circulation wear consistent with its age. Detail remains visible in Liberty's hair and the eagle's feathers.
