LOT 44 - 1889 Morgan Silver Dollar ANACS MS62



Description

ANACS certified 1889 Morgan Silver Dollar in Mint State 62 condition. Designed by George T. Morgan, this classic American silver dollar features Liberty's left-facing profile on the obverse with flowing hair adorned by a Phrygian cap, surrounded by stars and the date 1889. The reverse displays an American eagle with outstretched

wings enclosed by a wreath, with "ONE DOLLAR" at the bottom and "UNITED STATES OF AMERICA" along the top.

This Philadelphia mint issue (no mint mark) exhibits excellent strike quality with well-defined hair strands on Liberty and detailed feather definition on the eagle. The coin displays attractive mint luster with minimal contact marks consistent with the MS62 grade. Housed in a secure ANACS authentication holder with certification number 7592967, this encapsulation guarantees both authenticity and grade assignment.

The 1889 Morgan Dollar represents a key period in American monetary history when silver production was at its height following the Comstock Lode discoveries. With a mintage of approximately 21.7 million from the Philadelphia mint, this is a collectible example from one of America's most popular coin series, presented in original uncirculated condition.
