LOT 47 - 1883-O Morgan Silver Dollar ANACS MS62



Description

ANACS certified 1883-O Morgan Silver Dollar in Mint State 62 condition. Designed by George T. Morgan, this classic American silver dollar features Liberty's profile on the obverse with flowing hair adorned by a Phrygian cap, surrounded by thirteen stars and the date 1883. The reverse displays an American eagle with outstretched wings

enclosed by an olive wreath, with "ONE DOLLAR" at the bottom and "UNITED STATES OF AMERICA" along the top.

This New Orleans mint issue, as indicated by the "O" mint mark, exhibits good strike quality with well-defined hair strands on Liberty and detailed eagle feathers. The coin displays attractive mint luster with minimal contact marks consistent with the MS62 grade. Housed in a secure ANACS authentication holder with certification number 7592956, this encapsulation guarantees both the coin's authenticity and grade.

The 1883-O Morgan Dollar represents an important period in American monetary history when silver production was flourishing following the Bland-Allison Act of 1878. With a mintage of 8,725,000 from the New Orleans mint, this coin offers collectors an authentic piece of post-Reconstruction era southern mint production in original uncirculated condition.
