LOT 69 - Two Antique Morgan Silver Dollars, 1886-O & 1888



Description

Silver 90% Morgan Dollars, US Currency from late 19th century. These authentic antique coins feature Lady Liberty in profile on obverse with eagle reverse design. The pair includes a New Orleans minted 1886-O and 1888, representing key examples from this iconic American coinage series designed by George T. Morgan.

Both coins display the classic Liberty head profile with flowing hair adorned with cotton blossoms and wheat, surrounded by "E PLURIBUS UNUM" and 13 stars representing the original colonies. Reverse features American eagle with outstretched wings clutching arrows and olive branch, encircled by laurel wreaths with "UNITED STATES OF AMERICA" and "ONE DOLLAR" denomination.

Condition Notes: The 1886-O example (Top) shows heavier circulation wear with darkened patina and some surface abrasions. The 1888 coin (right) exhibits better detail retention with lighter toning and moderate circulation wear. Both coins show expected edge wear and surface marks consistent with age and monetary use. Refer to the pictures and in person inspection for condition.
