LOT 78 - Four Circulated Morgan Silver Dollars



Description

Silver 90% Morgan Dollars, late 19th century American coinage. This diverse group spans the final decade of the 19th century with dates ranging from 1890 to 1900, including examples from New Orleans and San Francisco mints. These authentic circulated dollars showcase the classic Liberty head design by George T. Morgan.

Set includes:

1. 1900-O Morgan Dollar (Upper left) - New Orleans mint, showing moderate circulation wear with some oxidation spots visible on the obverse.
2. 1900-O Morgan Dollar (Upper right) - Second New Orleans mint example, with slightly better detail retention than its counterpart.
3. 1890-O Morgan Dollar (Lower left) - Earlier New Orleans mint issue showing more pronounced wear, particularly on Liberty's hair details.
4. 1899-S Morgan Dollar (Lower right) - San Francisco mint example with significant circulation wear and edge smoothing.

All coins feature the classic Liberty head profile with flowing hair adorned with cotton blossoms and wheat, surrounded by stars and motto. Reverse shows American eagle with outstretched wings clutching arrows and olive branch, encircled by wreath and inscriptions.

Condition Notes: All coins show moderate to heavy circulation wear consistent with monetary use during their era. The 1899-S example shows the most significant wear with some details flattened. Several coins display minor oxidation spots and light rim dings. No major damage is evident beyond expected circulation wear. Refer to the pictures and in person inspection for condition.
