LOT 59B - 1879 Morgan Silver Dollar



Description

Silver one dollar coin from the early Morgan dollar series. This 1879-dated specimen features the classic Liberty head obverse design by George T. Morgan and eagle reverse. The coin displays a strong strike with well-defined feather detail on the eagle and clear hair lines on Liberty's portrait.

The 90% silver composition exhibits an attractive patina with subtle toning developed over 140+ years. The coin maintains good luster with no evidence of cleaning or polishing. Text and date details remain crisp with clearly visible denticles around both sides of the coin.

The coin is housed in a modern protective clear plastic holder with black foam insert and display stand, providing proper preservation while allowing full viewing of both sides.

Condition Notes: No visible major scratches, rim damage, or significant bag marks. Light natural toning consistent with age and proper storage. No evidence of harsh cleaning or artificial enhancement. Approximate grade appears to be AU (Almost Uncirculated). Refer to the pictures and in person inspection for condition.
