The fringe is hand-knotted and extends from the cotton warp threads, confirming the rug's traditional construction methods. Close examination of the pile reveals wool of good quality with a dense, uniform pile height.

This rug exemplifies the Chinese tradition of combining symbolic motifs with decorative elements. The balanced composition and careful placement of florals reflect traditional Chinese aesthetic principles, while the vibrant red ground color symbolizes prosperity and good fortune in Chinese culture.

Condition Notes: Overall good condition with some minor wear consistent with age and light use. The rich oxblood red field maintains strong color retention with minimal fading. Some flattening of pile in central areas. The fringe shows mild yellowing and some minor tangling. No significant stains, repairs, or structural damage noted.
