**LOT 215 - Two 1925-S Peace Silver Dollars**



**Description**

Pair of 1925-S Peace silver dollars, struck at the San Francisco Mint and composed of 90% silver. Designed by Anthony de Francisci, these coins depict Liberty on the obverse and an eagle at rest on the reverse—symbolizing the peace that followed World War I.

The 1925-S issue is known for softer strikes compared to its Philadelphia counterpart, making well-struck examples more sought after among collectors.

Condition notes: Both coins show moderate to heavy circulation wear with surface discoloration and toning. Details on the eagle and lettering remain partially visible. Housed in protective capsules. Refer to the pictures for condition.
