Description

Brass or Bronze vessel with hammered texture and Art Deco wave design. This decorative vase features a classic baluster form with distinctive horizontal ribbing around the neck and foot. The body displays a meticulously hammered surface texture creating a dimpled effect, while the central band showcases an elegant wave or scroll pattern characteristic of Art Deco design influence.

The vase exhibits a warm golden-brown patina with variations in tone highlighting the sculptural elements. Construction appears to be formed brass with hand-applied decoration. The open mouth and substantial footed base suggest both decorative and functional intent.

Dating to approximately 1920-1930, this piece represents the Art Deco period's emphasis on bold geometric patterns and textural contrast. The combination of horizontal banding with organic wave motifs exemplifies the fusion of machine-age aesthetics with naturalistic elements common in decorative arts of this era.

Minor surface patination consistent with age. Some darkening within recessed areas enhances the sculptural quality of the decoration. No visible cracks or structural damage apparent. Refer to the pictures and in-person inspection for condition.
