The geometric pattern showcases traditional Navajo weaving techniques, featuring a symmetrical arrangement of arrows and abstract forms against a brown field. The

border consists of contrasting black and cream sawtooth motifs with triangular designs framing the central pattern.

Some minor wear visible along edges consistent with age, with minor fraying in isolated areas along the black border as shown in images 7-9. Small areas of wear to fibers, but overall in good condition with no major damage or repairs. Colors remain vibrant with natural patina appropriate to age.
